I/We acknowledge and agree that:

- Applicants are subject to and will abide by all Union Bay Improvement District (UBID) bylaws and also understand that only some of the relevant provisions of those bylaws are referenced in this document. (UBID bylaws are available for viewing either at the UBID offices or on our website: www.union-bay.ca.)
- Applicant's are required to provide a **\$500.00 Service Connection Deposit** payable at the time of submission of this Application.
- A service connection, including installation of a water meter, will be provided by the District for which the applicant is solely responsible for the total actual costs for parts, labour and equipment rental to install such service, less the above-noted deposit paid in advance. Such costs may be upwards of **\$1,500.00** for a ¾" service connection. (Larger connections will likely be in excess of \$2,000.00.)
- These connection costs are in addition to:
 - o Any administrative and inspections charges that may be incurred; and
 - o any other rates, charges, fees, etc. as identified in the appropriate UBID Bylaws.
- Water will not be supplied by the District until all fees and/or charges as described above are paid in full.
- Curb stop valves are for the District's use only and must be uncovered and accessible at all times.
- The District has advised that, at minimum, the following be installed at my/our expense as the applicant:
 - o A water meter;
 - o A shut-off valve for emergencies and to facilitate changes to or cleaning of water lines on my/our property;
 - o A backflow preventer or other appurtenance on hot water tanks to prevent drain off during interrupted water service;
 - o A pressure reducing valve if I/we are in an area of high pressure; and
 - o A booster pump if I/we are in a low pressure area.
- All services and installations on my/our property must be conducted in accordance with the British Columbia Plumbing Code.
