

# Union Bay Improvement District General Local Election 2020 Notice of Nomination

Public Notice is given to the electors of the Union Bay Improvement District (UBID) that nominations for the office of:

## Two (2) UBID Trustee Positions

for a 3 year term commencing May 2020 and ending May 2023, will be received by the Returning Officer or a designated person between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm Tuesday to Thursday from March 5, 2020 to April 7, 2020 at the UBID office, 5579B South Island Highway, Union Bay, BC V0R 3B0. Alternatively, the nomination papers can be left in the after hours drop box outside the UBID office.

Nomination papers must be delivered to the UBID office before 4:00 pm on April 7, 2020.

### Qualifications for Office

Persons entitled to be nominated, elected and to hold office as a trustee must meet the following requirements:

- Canadian Citizen
- Eighteen years of age or older
- An owner of land in the UBID who has been on title for the last 30 days immediately prior to the day of registration
- A resident of BC for the prior six months
- Entitled to be registered as a voter under the Election Act

Nomination forms are now available for pick up either at the UBID office, 5579B South Island Highway, Union Bay, BC between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm Tuesday to Thursday or online on the UBID website at [www.union-bay.ca](http://www.union-bay.ca) until the closure of nominations.

Should three or more nomination papers be received, the Advance Election Poll will be held at the Union Bay Community Hall, 5401 South Island Highway, Union Bay, BC on April 14, 2020 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. The General Election Poll will be held at the Union Bay Community Hall, 5401 South Island Highway, Union Bay, BC on April 25, 2020 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm.
